MONTH 2 ~ "I'm dancing!" Your baby is making progress developing all of her external features and internal organs. Her brain is functioning at 40 days. Her mother can hear her heartbeat now on an ultrasonic stethoscope. At eight weeks after fertilization, your spiritually adopted baby moves from the embryonic to the fetal developmental stage. "Fetus" is a Latin word meaning "little one" and it reflects the new stage of development that this child is in now. Baby-teeth buds are present at 6 ½ weeks. The baby's central nervous system is functioning and 40 muscle sets begin their first exercises. The internal organs are all present when the fetal stage begins.
